Cut water costs, conserve water and earn rebates

Colorado residents who already had some type of water shut-off device on their sprinkler system almost paid for it this year in water savings when their sprinkler was NOT running during our many downpours. To keep your sprinklers OFF in the rain, consider installing a rain sensor to your sprinkler system. Purchasing and having a professional install a rain sensor usually costs less than \$100. Subtract a rebate and money saved on water bills and this one sprinkler system upgrade may actually cost very little.

Rebates: Denver Water and other water providers and some municipalities have programs in place to reward homeowners who install rain sensors to their irrigation systems. Some rebates are in the \$25 range, but for details of potential rebates in your area, check the websites for your water provider and municipality.
